

Provisional Pathological FIGO Stage Pre-MDTM* (Core and Non-core)

Reason/Evidentiary Support

Staging is provisional since final stage should be determined at multidisciplinary team/tumour board meeting when all relevant clinical and radiological information is available.^{1,2} Since serous EIC is regarded as a type of endometrial carcinoma, it is staged as FIGO stage IA (T1a).
